[12] How art thou fallen from heaven, O **Lucifer**, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! [13] For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: [14] I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. [15] Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the

sides of the pit.

John 14:30 KJV

Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in me.

Review & Herald, 1898

"Christ's subjects are those who keep his commandments. These only are counted as his subjects. If, after the light has come, the disobedient continue in transgression, they are subjects of the **kingdom of the prince of this world**. That which is born of the flesh is flesh; that which is born of the Spirit is spirit"

[20] And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the *kingdom of God* should come, he answered them and said, The kingdom of God cometh not with observation:
[21] neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the *kingdom of God* is within you.

Adversary (enemy)

1 Peter 5:8 KJV

Be sober, be vigilant; because your *adversary* the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour.

Satan is the god of the world; his influence is to pervert the senses, control the human mind for evil, and drive his victims to violence and crime. He sows discord and darkens the intellect. The work of Christ is to break his power over the children of men. Yet how many in every department of life, in the home, in business transactions, and in the church, turn Jesus from their doors but let the hateful monster in. ⁵The Signs of the Times, May 24, 1877 (The Spirit of Prophecy 2:317).

Deceiver

Revelation 12:9 KJV

And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which *deceiveth* the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Satan's path is the broadest and the most deceptive. It is made to appear the most attractive, while it is hard, mystifying, and full of disappointment. ⁶The Review and Herald, April 15, 1880.

The subtlety of Satan will not decrease, but the wisdom given to men through a living connection with the Source of all light and divine knowledge will be proportionate to his arts and wiles. ⁸The Review and Herald, August 4, 1910.

Liar (commandment breaker)

John 8:44 KJV

[44] Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

Accuser (of the brethren)

Revelation 12:10 KJV

And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven,

Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the *accuser of our brethren* is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

Job 1:8-9 KJV

[8] And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? [9] Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, Doth Job fear God for nought?

Christ's Object Lessons, Ch 14
