## The Nature of the Son of God Truth Seekers

Matthew 1:18 KJV

Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.

Fully human + fully divine = the Son of God Fully human = body + breath of life (Gen 2.7)

John 5:26 KJV

For as the Father hath **life** in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have **life** in himself;

**After the incarnation,** Jesus was no different than us.. except for his divinity, which he has possessed from eternity past,

He is the **eternal**, **self**-**existent Son**, on whom no yoke had come"

What about after the resurrection? No different, exactly the same, except a glorified human body,

John 20:27 KJV

Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.

Was His divine nature still **intertwined** with his human nature after the resurrection? Certainly so. Nowhere does the Bible say otherwise.

What about after the assension? No different, exactly the same, except a glorified human body,

Acts 1:9-11 KJV

[9] And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight. [10] And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel; [11] which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.

Was His *divine* nature still **intertwined** with his human nature after the assension? Certainly so. Nowhere does the Bible say otherwise.

Jesus **returns** at the Second Coming exactly how he left... **2** Human **2** God with a glorified human body + the breath of life, which by definition makes Him fully human.

Is this Jesus forever? Yes! According to EGW

"By His life and His death, Christ has achieved even more than recovery from the ruin wrought through sin. It was Satan's purpose to bring about an eternal separation between God and man; but in Christ we become more closely united to God than if we had never fallen. In taking our nature, the Saviour has bound Himself to humanity by a tie that is never to be broken. Through the eternal ages He is linked with us. "God so loved the world, that He gave His only-begotten Son." John 3:16. He gave Him not only to bear our sins, and to die as our sacrifice; He gave Him to the fallen race. To assure us of His immutable counsel of peace, God gave His only-begotten Son to become one of the human family, forever to retain His human nature." DA 25-26

"Forever to retain His human nature"

By definition, a **human being** = body (glorified, restored) + the breath of life (which He has within himself)

Genesis 2:7 KJV

And the LORD God formed man <u>of</u> the dust of the ground, and breathed into his <u>nostrils</u> the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Jesus's humanity is no different than ours, meaning He cannot exist apart from his glorified body. His "spirit" and literal body are forever linked, just like ours is. Take one away, Jesus ceases to exist.

There is nothing in the Bible or SOP that suggests that His human nature and his divine nature can **split**. They are forever intertwined according to Ellen White,

"Was the human nature of the Son of Mary changed into the divine nature of the Son of God? No; the two natures were **mysteriously blended** in *one person* - the man Christ Jesus" Letter 280, 1904

Remove the divine from the human, and the man Jesus Christ ceases to exist.

James 2:26 KJV

For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

To believe that He exists in spirit form apart from his glorified body is spiritualism, which

is condemned in the Bible and Ellen White,

Many will be ensnared through the belief that spiritualism is a merely human imposture; when brought face to face with manifestations which they cannot but regard as supernatural, they will be deceived, and will be led to accept them as the great power of God. 17The Great Controversy, 553.

Conclusion? Jesus is a real Person right now in the Most Holy place in the heavenly sanctuary. He exists exactly like he was after the resurrection,

# Human God with a glorified human body + the breath of life

Buying this theory shown below in the diagram in order to get to 3, splits Jesus in two, and violates the very definition of what it means to be a human being, contradicts the Bible and EGW on the nature of the Son, and creates a non-biblical Jesus, and is spiritualism.

2 Corinthians 11:4 KJV For if he that cometh preacheth another

Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.

Jesus Christ is a single package, as is God the Father, as is the Holy Ghost.

This is actually not much different than the Catholics taking out the 2nd commandment, and then splitting the 10th in order to keep 10. It's nonsense,



That's a **different Jesus** 1 and is *heresy*.

1 John 4.1-3 condemns the gnostic teaching of creating a different Jesus, who did not come in the flesh, they taught. This was

clearly not reality or biblical. He even calls it the "spirit of antichrist". This attempt to redefine Jesus into a human Jesus and a divine Jesus in order to get to three in the Godhead is no different.
